

Regulations of the Natural Park of the Ampezzo Dolomites

1. Motor vehicles cannot circulate within the Park, except for vehicles for silvo-pastoral work, mountain rescue and restocking of mountain huts. This also applies to low-altitude overflight and landing of aircraft and to the practice of heliskiing.
2. In the pre-park area, at the bottom of the valley, there are areas equipped for camper parking and camping; at higher altitudes there are fixed bivouacs and mountain huts equipped for overnight stays. Camping with tents and campers is therefore not permitted.
3. It is strictly forbidden to light fires - carelessness can destroy a centuries-old forest heritage.
4. It is forbidden to collect or damage any kind of plants and mushrooms, even those that are inedible. The collection of fossils and minerals and the demolition of rock, as well as the collection of war relics, is also prohibited.
5. Do not destroy minor fauna and do not damage the places of hatching and dwelling, as well as the feeding sites of animal species.
6. Take your waste home and leave the places where you have stopped clean.
7. Keep your dogs on a leash. Dogs not on a leash can disturb and injure the animals in the Park.
8. Do not ride your mountain bike along the trails. They are intended for hikers.
9. Do not damage signage and equipment. They are used for information and recreation.
